



## Free Paper Sessions- Roles for Chairs and Co-Chairs

### Chair

---

In the Free Paper sessions, the Chair is the active leader of the panel. The task of the Chair is to introduce the authors (just name and affiliation), lead the discussion for each presentation and take questions from the audience. Any transfer of tasks from the Chair to the Co-Chair (or vice versa) ahead of the session is at the discretion of the individual sessions.

### Co-Chair

---

The Co-chair has the task of supervising the session “on the day”. This means introducing the Chair and control the times. During the session, the Co-Chair can assist the Chair by contributing questions to the discussion. Any transfer of tasks from the co-chair to the chair ahead of the panel (or vice versa) is at the discretion of the individual sessions.
